**Thank you. And thank you again.** Your commitment to live theatre made possible this summer's joyous return to full capacity performances.

The coming season promises more to look forward to, including renovations to our indoor theatre to upgrade its acoustics and climate control system. Formerly known as the University Theatre, it will reopen for CSF 2023 as the **Roe Green Theatre**. In 2024 the **Mary Rippon Outdoor Theatre** and the **Hellems Building** will be closed for extensive renovation, making 2023 our last chance to enjoy the venue in its current configuration.

In the meantime, summer 2023's lineup is packed with stellar shows you won't want to miss. Outdoors boasts top tier titles: perennial favorite *Much Ado About Nothing* opens in June, followed by a thrilling *King Lear* in July. We'll open indoors with a magical *The Winter's Tale* followed by Richard Bean's hilarious comedy *One Man, Two Guvvners*. This year's Original Practice performance is the blockbuster *The Comedy of Errors*, for one night only.

Now's the time to renew! Season tickets go on sale Monday, Oct. 31. Purchasing season tickets unlocks great benefits including up to 30 percent savings and free exchanges. Order now to get the best seats in the house; single tickets go on sale Nov. 29. We have four season ticket options to fit every schedule and budget:

- **Full Season Ticket:** All four main plays. No date restrictions. 20% discount.

- **Choice 4+** or **Choice 6+:** Selections from across most year-round CU Presents performances. 15% or 20% discount.

## Much Ado About Nothing

Mary Rippon Outdoor Theatre

Beatrice and Benedick love to bicker. The only thing they might learn to love more? Each other. (They just don't know it yet!) In this rollicking lampoon of relationships, romance, and the influence of town gossip, Shakespeare delivers a near-perfect enemies-to-lovers romantic comedy.

## The Winter's Tale

Roe Green Theatre (Indoors)

When King Leontes inexplicably accuses his pregnant wife of infidelity he makes a cruel, rash decision that he must spend two decades atoning for. Shakespeare's nuanced epic explores both the heartrending corrosion of jealousy and the joyous redemption of forgiveness that is hard-won. Borrowing elements from fantasy and mythology, *The Winter's Tale* weaves an audacious tapestry you have to experience to believe.

## King Lear

Mary Rippon Outdoor Theatre

An aging King Lear decides to divide his kingdom among his three daughters, proportionally by who professes to love him most. His plotting comes to catastrophe and sees him cast from his own kingdom. Shakespeare's tumultuous tragedy explores speaking truth to power, the cost of grievous mistakes, and whether it's ever too late for redemption. *This production contains adult themes and effects, including simulated graphic violence.*
